There was a discussion on the budget that has yet to be passed because of cancelled meetings during the winter. The budget was presented to the board by the Secretary and a discussion followed regarding the budget. The district had been told by Sierra County Auditor, Don Hemphill, to expect our tax revenue to be cut this year by approximately \$3,000.

After a discussion on all catagories it was decided that there would be no major purchases for equipment this fiscal year. Director Lucchesi moves to pass the budget for fiscal year 1991-92. Director Street seconds. Ayes, unanimous. A copy of the completed budget is attached to the minutes.

#### New Business:

There was a discussion held on the current rate paid by the district for mileage. The current rate set by the IRS is 27.5 cents. ACWD's rate is 22 cents. The secretary has requested that the board raise the rate to conform with the current rate paid by most business's and government agencies. Director Street moves to raise the mileage rate from 22 cents to 27 cents, effective this meeting. Director Lucchesi seconds. Ayes, unanimous.

This meeting was called to order at 7:38 P.M. by Chairman Hauck Present were Directors Hauck, Street, Hiersche and Lucchesi Absent Director Standley, excused because of work out of town The minutes from the meeting of January 14, 1992 were read and approved as read.

#### Engineers Report:

At this time the Board recognizes and thanks the District Engineer Keith Sauers for attending our meeting and giving us a report on the status of the Community Development Block Grant that ACWD is in the process of applying for. The initial meeting with the State and the Chairman of the ACWD was held approximately 4 months prior. We were told that there was a possiblility that funding was available thru a block grant. Also attending that meeting was Keith Sauers and a Representative from the Community Development Block Grant program. We were told that the funds could be made available through the Sierra County Board of Supervisors. The available funding maximum is \$500,000.

Keith explained that the State Health Dept has met and talked to him about the EPA State requirements for water testing that will go into effect next year. The Ram Spring has been reclassified as a surface water source. If we are to get around the new surface water treatment rules we must have the Ram Spring classified as a well source. Keith made a presentation to the board about possible methods to meet the new standards.

The Board and our Engineer must focus their attention on several different projects. 1) Develop the Ram with filltration

systems and teatment facilities. This would bring us within compliance of the new EPA standards. 2) Finish looping the system with 6" pipe which would replace the existing 2" loop at the end of town from the park to the Hope residence to the MeLeod residence. This would also provide for the addition of several new fire hydrants that would replace the old 2" ones that exist on that line at this time.

The application must go to the Board of Supervisors on March 17, 1992. John Sheenan, from the Plumas County Community Development Commission, Keith Sauers, Chairman Hauck, Director Lucchessi, and Secretary Hauck will appear before the Board of Supervisors to make a presentation for acceptance by Sierra County of the Block Grant funds for our project. Their are several hurdles to cross before that meeting. 1) The Board (ACWD) must approve our Engineer submitting a report for the project, and 2) the Board of Supervisors must agree and vote in favor of our application for the grant. Engineer Sauers is asking the ACWD for final approval and direction on the scope of the project to be submitted. A discussion followed with the Board accepting the Engineers recommendation for the filtration plant facilities and upgrade on the existing 2" line. recommended that we forget about the renovation of the Comberland Tunnel at this time.

Director Lucchesi moves to proceed with the project that has been recommended by our Engineer, Keith Sauers, through the Community Development Block Grant process. Director Street seconds. Ayes, unanimous.

There was a discussion held on a notice from Sierra County Don Hemphill informing the district about a proposal from the Governor of California, Pete Wilson, to transfer Special District tax revenue to the School Districts. This would be a disaster for District.

Director Lucchesi moves for the Secretary to draft a letter to the customers of the ACWD addressing the problem of "Transfer of Enterprise Special District Property Tax Revenue" and asking our customers to send letters and phone calls to the Governor. Director Street seconds. Ayes, unanimous.

There was a discussion on the new Workmans Compensation Insurance rates being imposed on the District. Director Hiersche moves for the Secretary to secure quotes from several other carriers. Director Lucchesi seconds. Ayes, unanimous.

Treasury Report: Park Fund, Maintenance Fund, General Fund \$18,093.72

#### Status Report:

The septic tank at the park is full again. There is a pumping service out of Sierraville that will come to Alleghany to pump the tank. He will charge \$300.00 a truck load but his truck is not big enough to make it in one trip so the cost would double to \$600.00. Discussion held on having the same company come up that came last year. The secretary is to call and make the arrangements. The secretary is also directed to call Merrill & Sons (who supplied the holding tank) and discuss the problem we are having. It may be necessary for them to come up and look at the tank. A discussion is held on why the tank is filling up with water so quickly. The district is hoping a major repair job will not be necessary.

Trees have fallen at the park that will have to be removed. The Chairman to ask Ray Simpson if he would like to have the wood from the trees. Cleanup of the park will have to be arranged.

At the Ram Spring pumphouse there may be a problem with the sump. The Chairman to contact the pump service that installed our pumps to see if extension pipes installed on the pumps will help.

A fence section at the rear of the Ram Spring area has been broken by a tree limb that has fallen this winter. A discussion is held on possible means of repair. The Chairman to contact Ed Barker for an estimate on repairs if he is interested in doing the work.

#### Old Business:

A discussion was held on the grant application that went before the Sierra County Board of Supervisors. Chairman Hauck, Director Lucchesi, Secretary Hauck, Engineer Keith Sauers and John Shehan, from Plumas County, all traveled to Loyalton to make a presentation to the Board of Supervisors. After some questions from the board about language in the contract with Sierra County and the Federal Government a vote was held. The District Attorney of Sierra County wanted some changes made in the contract. Mr. Shehan was agreeable to the changes. The Board of Supervisors then held a vote and it was passed unanimously for the Board of Supervisors to support the ACWD's application for a grant to improve the water system.
