Water Test - Water test results for December - Absent Treasury Report: Park, Maintenance, and General Fund = \$12,684.00

Status Report:

1. Tank site is fully secured however the tank will need to be repainted this year. Repairs at the Ram spring site are proceeding. The ditch has been dug. The water district is waiting for 1 more estimate for guniting the ditch area. Hanson Brothers has bid \$3,000 for the job. The pump house has been readied for the winter. Insulation is needed again for the water boxes. The Chairman will purchase the insulation.

- 1. Mike Miller has appeared before the board regarding a disconnect notice he has received for the house on main street next to the store. Mr. Miller would like the board to forgive the excess charges due to a major water leak at the house. Mr. Miller has brought sufficient evidence to the board to show that the water usage was because of vandalism when the house was vacant. A discussion follows. Director Lucchesi moves to credit Mr. Millers bill for the excessive water used and for the secretary to recalculate the water bill from that point forward adding interest for that portion of the regular bill which has remained unpaid. Director Hauck seconds. Ayes, Lucchesi and Hauck. Abstain, Street. Mr. Miller will pay the bill in full as soon as he receives a revised billing for that property.
- 2. Debra Nelson has a disconnect scheduled for January 20th. She was unable to appear before the board because she had an accident. There was a discussion on a reasonable payment plan which would allow her to bring her

bill current. Director Street moves to accept a \$70.00 payment by the 20th of January. This payment must be cash. The balance is to be paid at \$25.00 per month plus the regular billing of 18.00. To avoid disconnect this schedule must be met on time every month. Director Lucchesi seconds. Ayes, unanimous.

3. Discussion held on the Block Grant with Sierra Economic Development District. The district has not heard from Martin Zone this month. The Sierra County Board of Supervisors are to decide if set back requirements will be waived. They also have to approve Keith Sauers as project engineer for the construction on the water system.



Public Hearing called to order at 7:50pm Present at the public hearing were: David Hartwell from Plumas County, Jeff Seppet from the State of California Department of Health Services and Karen Nelson from Sauers Engineering in Nevada City.

David Hartwell gave an overview of the project and how his agency will be ACWD's agent in administering the grant funds. Sierra County will also be responsible for overseeing the funds. Mr. Hartwell stated that from this point

on he would be attending all the district's scheduled meetings.

Jeff Seppet was introduced as the State of Calif., Department of Health 2. Services representative from the Redding, CA office. He was responsible for conducting our annual inspection of the water system. Mr. Seppet will be responsible for seeing that the new filtering system meets all state

requirements of water quality.

Karen Nelson is the district's engineer for the project. She gave an overview of her preliminary report that was received by all the directors prior to this hearing. Chairman Hauck directed several questions to Karen Nelson that had to do with her report. There were several corrections to the report that had to be made. Fees were discussed that were listed in the cost estimates of the report. A discussion was held on warranties relating to the manufacturers specs of the filtration equipment. A question and answer period was held for the benefit of the district's board of directors.

Water Test - Water test results for June 1994 - absent. Water test for July has not come back yet.

Treasury Report: Park, Maintenance, and General Fund = \$18,827.41

Status Report:

1. Valve by Millers house is leaking, cannot be repaired. #1 pump is acting up. The Water Company that replaced the pump last year failed to warranty the pump. Repair man says that the pump needs to be calibrated. The water is very cloudy right now. The new chlorinator is installed. The bathroom at the park is still full. Need to purchase roundup to spray around the water tank. Discussion held on the need to brush the Ram Spring and the Cumberland. The Chairman will post for the work opportunity. Bids will be received until Tuesday. The Chairman will award the contract to the lowest bidder.

Public Response Time: None

Unfinished Business:

- 1. Discussion held on the billing accounts. Rowland house has been bought by Ercell Coons and the Hiersche house has been bought by Lucretia Miller. There are 3 disconnects scheduled for July 25th if payment is not received.
- 2. The deadline has passed for submission of bids on the water system improvements. All bids were over by a minimum of 50,000. The cost overruns were attributed to the high cost of hauling materials for the pipe line construction phase. There were a total of 3 bids. If the Board of Supervisors select one of the bidders we will have to cut costs by reducing the length of the 6" main by approximately 500 feet. If the Board of

Supervisors throw out all the bids there is a possibility that someone may submit a new bid within the budget available.

New Business:

- 1. Resolution #86 is presented to the board for approval. "A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ELECTION OF OFFICERS OF THE ALLEGHANY COUNTY WATER DISTRICT TO BE CONSOLIDATED WITH THE GENERAL ELECTIONS". Director Lucchesi moves to approve Resolution #86. Director Street seconds. Ayes, unanimous.
- 2. A preliminary discussion was held on the budget for Fiscal Year 1994/95. Actual expenditures for last year totaled \$19,711.58. Directors were asked to consider items needed for this coming fiscal year 94/95 so they may be discussed when it is time to pass the budget.



Status Report:

There was a meeting on August 22nd with Chairman Hauck, Dave The Contractor is in town and on the job for Hartwell, and the Contractor. the last 2 days. The new pipe line has been moved 8 feet to the edge of the road. The problems with Pump #1 have not gone away. Pump #1 has finally quit and we will be using only Pump #2 for the time being. Since new pumps will be installed during construction we will not be repairing pump #1. The chairman has sprayed around the tank to cut down the weeds but the trees still need some attention. Mike Miller needs to fix the road to the Cumberland. PG&E has been complaining about it. The chairman will talk to him. There is a backhoe in town because of the construction on the water system so maybe that will help. The septic in the park restroom still needs to be pumped. The chairman will try to make arrangements to have it done. The park was vandalized by two children in town. They were seen by an adult who reported it to the Chairman. The sheriff was called and a complaint was filed. The children were cited for the vandalism.

Public Response Time: None

Unfinished Business:

1. Dave Hartwell was at the meeting to discuss the progress of the construction. In the next two weeks the shut off valves will need to be

located for repair. We still need to make a fire plan to file with the county for the time during construction that might be shut down. Engineer Keith Sauers states that the pump house will have to be cleared out before the contractor can start his work at the Ram Spring.

- 2. The Chairman and the Secretary will be on vacation the first 2 weeks of October. The October meeting will be rescheduled for October 18th. The Secretary has asked the board permission to bill for September at the base rate since she will not be here for the meter readings. She will adjust the billings the following month if necessary. Director Street moves to allow the Secretary to bill for the month of September at the base rate. Director Lucchesi seconds. Ayes, unanimous.
- 3. There are no applications for the vacancy on the board.
- 4. A discussion was held on the preliminary budget for FY 1994-95, a copy of which is attached to these minutes. The board discussed the various categories in the budget. The budget is tabled until the next meeting where it will be discussed and adopted.


